The guidelines are to incorporate best practices across Canada and are meant to ensure a consistency of care throughout the field.

Each proposal must include the names, contact information and credentials, of all individuals included in the project. The proposal must outline, in detail, the strategies to be undertaken to achieve the outcomes required by the COHNA. An individual timeline, as well as a cost quotation for the project are essential elements of the proposal.
